

## 2009 Schedule of Fees and Charges

### Enrolment Fees

Application Fee \$220 (Incl. GST)	(Non refundable) to be sent with Application.
Acceptance Fee \$1000	(Non refundable) is required to confirm when the College offers a place.
Deposit of \$1500	Payable 18 months prior to commencement at the College. Provided that the student commences her studies at Roseville College in the year offered, and completes Senior School at the College, then the Deposit will be refunded without interest when all accounts are settled.
	<b>These fees are payable per student and are not credited towards School fees.</b>

### **Extra Charges**

Extra charges will apply for girls studying the following practical subjects; Design and Technology, Photography, Textiles and Design and Visual Arts in the Senior School. Additional charges will also be made for camps, special presentations and programs, excursions, elective sports and textbooks supplied by the College.

### **Extra Subjects**

A wide selection of optional extra subjects in cultural and sporting activities is available. A list of these subjects is distributed to all present and new students before the commencement of each year, with details of the individual charges per semester. In some cases the College acts as a facilitator only for the various contractors who provide these services. The contractors will forward invoices to parents and cheques should be returned directly to the contractor.

### **Concession for Sisters Attending the College at the Same Time**

A 10% concession of school fees will be granted to the second and subsequent sisters attending the College at the same time and where no other concession applies, eg. a scholarship.

### **Payment of Fees and Charges**

Fees and charges are due and payable in advance on or before the commencement of each term to which they relate. Accounts not paid within 30 days may incur an administration charge, unless a specific written settlement arrangement has been made with the College. There are several options available for the payment of School fees and charges. These include:

1. Full payment by cheque at the commencement of each term
2. BPAY (including debit or credit card link to bank account)
3. Fortnightly or monthly instalments by direct debit
4. The entire year's school fees at the commencement of the year

Where circumstance arise that may prevent timely settlement, contact should be made with the College office at the address/telephone numbers shown on the statement where it may be possible to make alternative suitable payment arrangements. Fees and charges not paid by the end of term, or not the subject of an approved arrangement, may lead to the exclusion of the student from the following term.

### **Building Fund** (ABN 95 574 523 186)

Future development of the College relies to a considerable extent on money raised through voluntary contributions to the Roseville College Building Fund. Building alterations, minor building projects, major renovations and new buildings are made possible by Building Fund donations, as School Fees are not set to cover all this work. The College encourages all parents to contribute to this fund. The suggested level of donation for 2008 is \$150 per term per family. All donations to the Roseville College Building Fund are **fully tax deductible**.

### **Withdrawal**

A student's enrolment is deemed to be continuous for the span of education years provided by the College.

A full College term's notice in writing is required before a girl leaves the College, or a full term's fees will be charged in lieu of this. For example if you wish to withdraw your daughter at the end of Term 4, the Principal must be notified in writing by the end of Term 3.
