Annabelle among Top 140 at International Science School

Roseville College Year 11 student Annabelle O'Regan recently attended the prestigious Professor Harry Messel International Science School at the University of Sydney in July.

Selected as one of 140 bright and highly motivated students from Years 11 and 12, Annabelle joined peers from around Australia and nine other countries for two weeks of lectures, workshops and special activities.

Young science scholars fortunate to attend the School were inspired by talented science communicator Dr Karl Kruszelnicki and heard lectures from international research pioneers including Professor Julius Sumner Miller, Nobel Laureates Dr James Watson (The Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine 1962), Dr Jerome Friedman (The Nobel Prize in Physics 1990), The Rt. Hon. The Lord Robert May of Oxford (OM AC Kt FRS, The Blue Planet Prize 2001) and Dr Margaret Burbidge (Astrophysicist, US National Medal of Science 1985, – and asteroid 5490 Burbidge is named after her).
