### Year 6 Swimmer heads to Nationals

**Roseville College Year 6 athlete Alice Stuart, of Roseville, has been selected to represent NSW in four events at the School Sport Australia Swimming Championships in Perth this September.**

The keen swimmer, who trains with the Macquarie University Swimming Club for seven sessions a week, gained her selection after performing strongly at the NSW Primary Schools Sports Association (PSSA) Swimming Championships recently.

“Alice is a talented girl and we are becoming quite accustomed to her high achievements in swimming,” says head of Junior School at Roseville College Mrs Julia Elsey.

“It seems that being the school’s 2009 Junior School Swimming Champion and part of our successful relay team at the international Pacific School Games will be just two of her many accomplishments in the pool this year,” she adds.

Included in Alice’s program at Nationals are the 50m and 100m Butterfly, 200m Individual Medley and 4x50m Medley Relay.

Like many girls at Roseville, Alice started swimming at a young age to gain confidence in the water and participate in a sporting activity. Roseville College has a strong record in water sports, with success in sports such as swimming and rowing. With good training facilities on campus, including a sheltered six-lane lap pool and gym, and easy access to resources in the local community, girls enjoy opportunities to try sports in and on the water.
