Dear Parents,

As you are aware, New South Wales is on high alert to contain the spread of the Human Swine Influenza (H1N1). Schools have been briefed by the NSW Department of Health, and are receiving regular updates on control procedures for restricting the spread of this disease.

Under advice from the NSW Department of Health, and in line with all NSW Schools, Roseville College is now undertaking the following:

1. If your daughter travels to Mexico, USA, Canada, Japan and/or Panama, we request she remain at home for seven (7) days (the maximum incubation period for the virus), following her travel, and before returning to school. This will allow time for any illness related to that travel to develop, and for prompt assessment and treatment to commence. If your daughter remains well after seven days she can return to school.
2. If families are planning to travel to these areas, please advise your daughter's Year Adviser or the Head of Junior School of the location and dates of travel.
3. Parents need to remain aware that the list of affected countries may change.
4. Parents should note that Roseville College will supply work for your daughter via RoseNet should this situation eventuate.

In the case that Roseville College needs to close, all teachers of Kindergarten to Year 12 students will provide lesson materials via our school intranet, RoseNet. Students should ensure they access RoseNet on a daily basis during a closure period. Junior School parents will be sent a note on how to access and set a password on RoseNet.
