

2011 HSC Results

We warmly congratulate the class of 2011. Roseville College had 93 students who received a Higher School Certificate and almost one quarter of its students achieved an ATAR of 95 or more. 46% of its students achieved an ATAR of 90 or over and 78% of its students gained an ATAR of 80 or more. Roseville is a completely non-selective school, and these exceptional results are a wonderful reflection of the girls' dedication and hard work.

A Balanced Approach: These outstanding results are also a reflection of the girls' balanced approach to their studies. Not only did our girls work hard, but they also participated in a wide variety of co-curricular activities and contributed a great deal to the life of Roseville College.
