

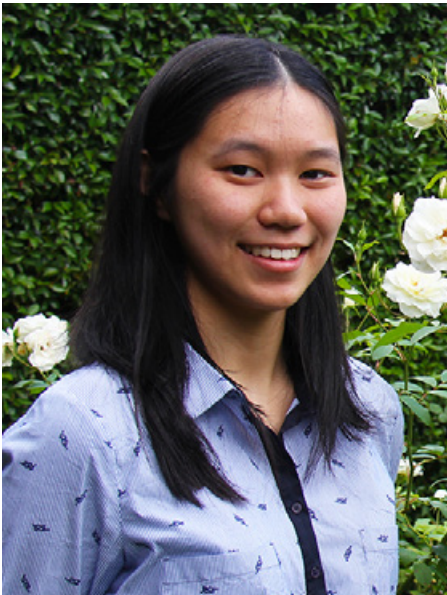
# 2015 OUTSTANDING HSC RESULTS

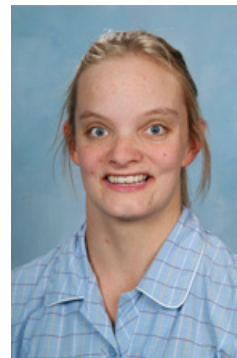

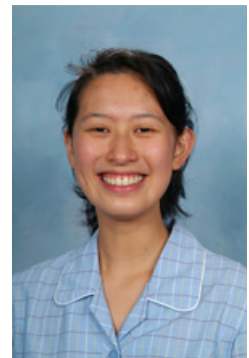
