3 Roseville girls receive Premier's Awards

Roseville College placed 35th in the State in the merit list of top Schools

We congratulate the Class of 2005 on their outstanding HSC results and in particular Emilia Esterman, Jessica Robinson and Jennifer Urwin, who received the prestigious Premier's Award for achieving a mark of 90 or above in at least 10 units.

Special mention also goes to Emma Raine, Reomi Mito and Erin Higgins who achieved 9 units of 90 or above.

Roseville Girls continue to EXCEL!

- 4% attained a UAI over 99
- 20% attained a UAI over 95
- 42% attained a UAI over 90
- 52% attained a UAI over 88
- 60% attained a UAI over 85
- 70% attained a UAI over 80
- 45% achieved a Band 5 or 6 in at least 10 units
- 87% of Year 12 applicants received first-round offers in a University course of their choice and 99% of students were eligible for an offer
- Roseville College girls received 126 mentions in the Board of Studies Distinguished Achievers' List of students who were placed in the highest Band, Band 6, representing a mark of 90 or above in individual subjects

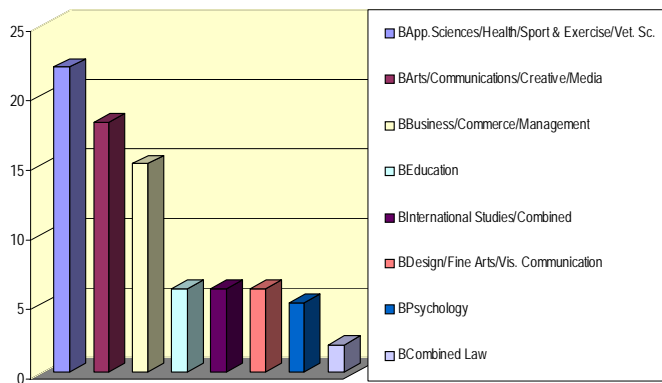
Reomi Mito

- **Jessica Mason and Annelise Reinthal** were each awarded a Macquarie University School Partners Sports Scholarship

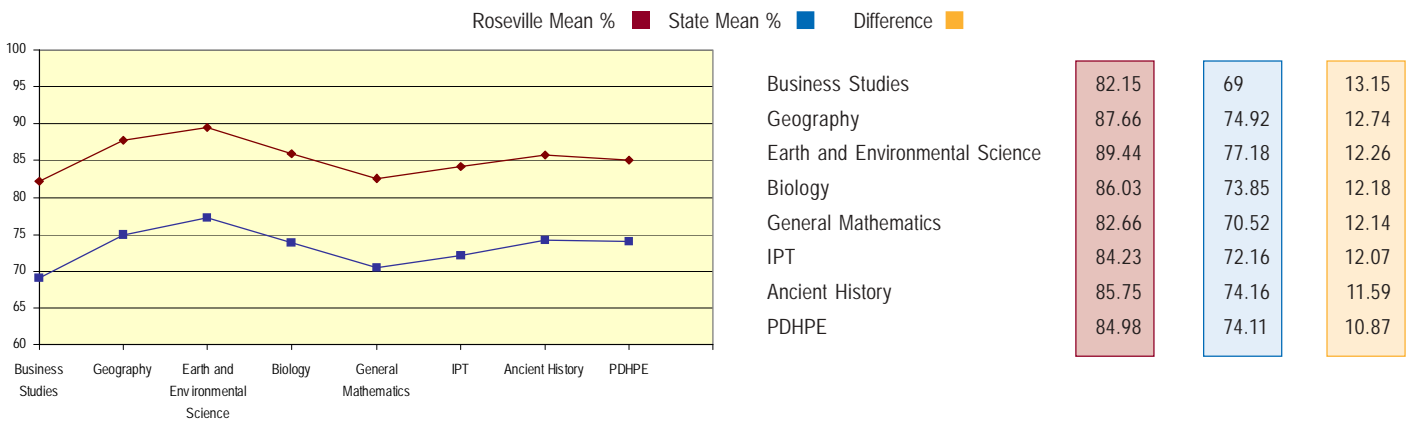
University courses chosen by Roseville Students in 2006
