We congratulate the class of 2007. Roseville College had a cohort of 77 students who received both a Higher School Certificate and a UAI.

TWO ROSEVILLE GIRLS – KIERA ROBERTS and LAUREN SMITH RECEIVED PREMIER'S AWARDS. The Premier's Awards are given to those students who achieve 90 or more (Band 6) in at least 10 units of study.

Kiera Roberts [left] was the Roseville College Dux as well as the HSC Dux. She received a UAI of 99.35 and has chosen to study for a Bachelor of Medicine/Bachelor of Surgery at the University of New South Wales. Kiera was also awarded a \$4000 scholarship by the University of New South Wales.

Lauren Smith [right] received a UAI of 98.8 and has chosen to study for a Bachelor of International Studies at the University of Sydney. Special mention also goes to Katherine Montano who achieved 9 units of 90 or above.
