Congratulations to our Year 12 Class of 2022 on their achievements demonstrated in the Higher School Certificate results released today. Their results are strong. They have achieved the highest number of top band results in the College's history, demonstrating what we know of this cohort - they are impressive.

Roseville College's results are consistently strong. As a non-selective school, we are proud to be ranked 30th out of over 650 schools in the Sydney Morning Herald's HSC school ranking this year (up 13 places from 2021). And while it is never a measure we rely on, it is pleasing to see the girls' efforts rewarded. We are a school that encourages our students to embrace rigour and challenge, and their achievements reflect this. In fact, over 60% of students achieved an ATAR of 90 or more and 30% above 95.

Today is a day of celebration, for excellent academic achievement for our girls, and in acknowledgement of the skill and dedication of our teachers. Even more importantly, it is a celebration of the demonstrated commitment and character each one of our students has shown during their time at Roseville College.

Congratulations especially to Rachel Park for her First in Course in Korean and Literature and All Rounders Zoe Balanco, Clara Cho, Anna Dong and Sophie Grant. We also acknowledge Top Achievers Sophie Grant who achieved 10th place in Society and Culture and Sophie Viol who came 16th in Modern History.

At Roseville College, a high ATAR is never the full story. Scattered across these results we acknowledge the gentle, personal victories for many, the immense dedication for most, and the overcoming of significant challenges for some. We congratulate each one.

Instead of focusing on what they missed, Year 12 2022 focused on what matters to us: in seeking truth, in learning and integrity, in love; in their genuine compassion and care for each other and their Roseville sisters big and small, and in hope. These girls graduate full of hope with a world of opportunity at their feet.
