Conditions

- 1. One Scholarship, based on academic merit and financial need, is available to a girl currently studying at another school and wishing to attend Roseville College for entry into either Year 7, Year 10 or Year 11. A means test will be applied to both Parents/Guardians and will be held confidentially by a committee comprising the Principal and the Director of Business Services.
- 2. The Foundation Scholarship provides 100% concession in tuition fees for the duration of their study at the College, provided the work and conduct of the Scholar are thoroughly satisfactory. All other costs are payable by the parent(s)/guardian(s). These include, but are not limited to: camp, uniforms, textbooks, involvement in sport or other co-curricular activities.
- 3. Applicants must currently be in either Year 6, Year 9 or Year 10 (2023).
- 4. Applicants should submit copies of their most recent school report and Naplan report (as applicable), and a confidential report from the Principal of her current school, if such can be obtained.
- 5. Should the applicant be successful in being awarded a Scholarship, the applicant will be required to complete an enrolment application form as part of the acceptance process.
- 6. Applications are invited by advertisement in the press before the closing date.
- 7. The Foundation Scholarship is awarded after consideration of the applications and reports. An interview with the Principal will be required. The College has absolute discretion to withhold the Scholarship from any applicant and is not required to give any reason for so doing.
- 8. No student may hold two Roseville College bursaries or scholarships concurrently.
