

Staff, students and visitors are encouraged to use public and active transport when travelling to and from Roseville College.

Plan your journey by accessing transportnsw.info, downloading the Opal app for smartphones or calling Transport NSW on 131 500 for up-to-date timetable information.

If active and public transport are not suitable alternatives for you, plan your journey before your arrival. There are limited on-street parking spaces available in the vicinity of the school.

Walk

If your journey starts within 800m from Roseville College, consider walking as a mode of travel. There are excellent pedestrian facilities in the area.



Cycle

Cycling might be an option if you are located within 2km from the school.

In NSW, cyclists under the age of 16 and adults (accompanying these children) can ride on the footpath. Take advantage of the footpath infrastructure around the school.



Train

Roseville College is located within a 6min walk from Roseville station, providing easy access for those travelling on the T1 North Shore and T9 Northern lines. During peak hours, services arrive every 9–15 minutes.



Metro

The M1 line provides convenience for those living near Epping. Change at Chatswood to a train with Roseville only one stop away.



Bus

You can catch one of the many bus lines serving the Roseville College area. There are bus stops within walking distance from the school along Boundary Road, Archbold Road, Hill Street and the Pacific Highway.

Private school bus

The Lower Northern Beaches private school bus services North Balgowlah, Balgowlah and Seaforth.

Public school bus

A public school bus dedicated to Roseville College students operates each afternoon from Boundary Road to Belrose.

Boundary Road

Frequent services connection between Chatswood interchange and Frenchs Forest and Terrey Hills area. The routes include 278, 279, 280, 281, 282, 283 and 284.

Archbold Road at Earl Street

Routes 194, 206, 207, 208, 209 and 594 are available servicing St Ives, Cammeray, Castle Cove, Castlecrag and Northbridge.

Hill Street

Route 558 operates with a one-hour frequency during the day between Chatswood Interchange and Lindfield.
